the ageing goethe finds new inspiration and youthfulness through the love of a young woman and the example of the great persian poet hafez johann wolfgang von goethe 1749 1832 a towering figure in german culture was remarkably prolific in many literary genres but much of his work is scarcely known in the english speaking world with this new translation robert martin tries to remedy this situation with regard to one of goethe s most adventurous volumes of verse the west eastern divan here goethe playfully pretends to be a middle eastern poet but draws on themes vital to all of humanity love creativity wisdom richness of life back cover the famous bucher bewegten die welt eine kulturgeschichte des buches 2d ed verlag anton hiersemann 1968 is a rich history of books and publishing and libraries much attention is devoted to the development of printing and the rise of the great modern research libraries an emphasis is placed throughout on the relationship between political or social movements and libraries translations of goethe s poems about arabia and persia and his essays on islamic culture büttikofer s travel sketches from liberia details the development of the liberian nation and the intricate often volatile relationships between the country s indigenous peoples and its black colonists from america in remarkable detail it provides vivid images of the country s past hiller s treatise on vocal performance and ornamentation was published in germany in 1780 and is an important manual on vocal technique and performance in the eighteenth century hiller was a masterful educator and was active not only as a teacher but as a critic composer conductor and music director thus his observations served not only to raise the standards of singing in germany based on the italian model but to present complicated material particularly ornamentation in a manner that his peers the middle class could emulate this present edition translated with an introduction and extensive commentary by musicologist suzanne j beicken makes hiller s treatise available for the first time in english with its emphasis on practical aspects of ornamentation declamation and style it will be valuable to instrumentalists as well as singers and is a significant contribution to the understanding of performance practice in the eighteenth century sheriff gideon johann has left the past behind and is enjoying his new life with his childhood sweetheart abby he crosses paths with a down on his luck buddy from the war and takes on the challenge of aiding finnie in the same way that last stand last chance saloon she finds her life turned upside down when gideon recruits her in his quest to get the charming little irishman finnie back on his feet gideon s daughter joann comes for a visit from the wyoming territory her brief romance with gideon s friend zack has ended and the two young adults find their new relationship angst filled and a comical calamity the reformed church historian and orientalist johann heinrich hottinger 1620 1667 is a key figure in the history of arabic and islamic studies in early modern europe his life and his work have been almost completely neglected and there has never been a full length study on hottinger this book presents a thorough documentation of hottinger s arabic and islamic studies based on printed books and a great number of unpublished and hitherto unknown manuscripts the book assesses his scholarship in the context of seventeenth century oriental studies and confessional rivalries the book contains a biographical account of hottinger and inserts him into the zurich tradition of oriental studies which can be traced back to theodor bibliander and konrad pellikan in the sixteenth century it gives an account of his years as a student of jacobus golius in leiden where hottinger copied and collected an impressive number of arabic manuscripts on which he later based his teaching and his publications the book explores hottinger s network in the protestant republic of letters and it contains studies of his activities as a bibliographer of arabic texts as a teacher of the arabic language as a linguist who promoted a comparative approach to oriental languages as a student of the history of islam and as a protestant who used his knowledge of arabic and of islam in the theological debates of the time the series religion and society rs contributes to the exploration of religions as social systems both in western and non western societies in particular it examines religions in their differentiation from and intersection with other cultural systems such as art economy law and politics due attention is given to paradigmatic case or comparative studies that exhibit a clear theoretical orientation with the empirical and historical data of religion and such aspects of religion as ritual the religious imagination constructions of tradition iconography or media in addition the formation of religious communities their construction of identity and their relation to society and the wider public are key issues of this series west östlicher divan is a diwan or collection of lyrical poems by the german poet johann wolfgang von goethe it was inspired by the persian poet hafez a recipient of the prose 2017 honorable mention in chemistry physics radioactivity introduction and history from the quantum
