the story s narrator is an animal lover who as he descends into alcoholism and perverse violence begins mistreating his wife and his black cat pluto when pluto attacks him in self defense one night he seizes the cat in a fury cuts out one of its eyes and hangs it first a brief summary of the plot of the black cat the narrator explains how from a young age he was noted for his tenderness and humanity as well as his fondness for animals when he married he and his wife acquired a number of pets including a black cat named pluto the black cat is a gothic horror tale by edgar allan poe who relies on supernatural elements to portray the dark side of human nature the tale was first published in the saturday evening post in august 1843 and examines the sources of sin the consequences of alcohol addiction and science versus the supernatural through the lens of provoked by the narrator s guilt and paranoia the cat appears to return in the body of a doppelganger this time with a white patch on his breast in the shape of a gallows warning the narrator of his fate the cat becomes a symbol of the narrator s delusional altered state the narrator of the black cat tells us of his boyhood which was easy he had a particular love of animals and had a lot of pets and this love only increased into adulthood he thinks there is something in the loyalty and unselfishness of a dog that you can t get from a man among birds goldfish a dog rabbits and a monkey the narrator singles out a large and beautiful black cat b named pluto as his favorite though he loves pluto the narrator begins to suffer from violent mood swings predominantly due to the influence of alcohol the black cat summary character list glossary themes quotes and analysis the black cat summary and analysis symbols allegory and motifs metaphors and similes irony imagery black cat superstitions literary elements related links essay questions quizzes test yourself quiz 1 quiz 2 citations study guide the cat seemed to enjoy being petted and purred and stretched the narrator tried to buy him from the bar owner who said the cat wasn t his to sell when the narrator headed home the cat followed him the woman loved the cat right away but the cat got on the man 39 s nerves and grossed him out summary and analysis the black cat summary more than any of poe 39 s stories the black cat illustrates best the capacity of the human mind to observe its own deterioration and the ability of the mind to comment upon its own destruction without being able to objectively halt that deterioration he begins by describing his kind and humane younger self he keeps many pets because animals such as dogs are so loving and faithful and at a young age he marries a woman who also loves pets in their household they have a number of animals including a large and beautiful black cat named pluto

edgar allan poe s short story the black cat uses an unreliable narrator to tell a story of unrelenting mental instability that ends with a killer s self revelation of his deadly deed the narrator boasts of his well known kindness and compassion towards animals which was mirrored by his wife the black cat by edgar allan poe published 1845 for the most wild yet most homely narrative which i am about to pen i neither expect nor solicit belief mad indeed would i be to expect it in a case where my very senses reject their own evidence yet mad am i not and very surely do i not dream the black cat summary i n edgar allan poe s the black cat an unreliable first person narrator relates how alcohol and self deception led him to kill his pets and murder his wife in a plot the story is presented as a first person narrative using an unnamed unreliable narrator who is awaiting execution 3 he describes his lifelong love of animals and the many pets that he and his wife have taken in including a large black cat named pluto the black cat is a tale that explores daemonic force symbolized by the cat itself not only were cats often associated with dark powers but there are also other factors that support this claim based on the scholarship of the daemonic the black cat black cats which are often associated with supernatural events show up twice in the story the narrator 39 s first cat pluto and the cat he meets after pluto 39 s death are the black cat summary the black cat by edgar allan poe this edgar allan poe story has many of the characteristics typical of his works it is written as a first person confession has a creepy mood and a haunting ending the narrator begins by explaining that he has always loved animals the black cat summary from his prison cell the unnamed narrator is writing the story of how everything in his life fell apart since he will die the next day he wants to set the record straight and tells us the story of his life from the day he is born he is mild and kind he loves animals and has lots of them
